

## **GLACUHO Contemporary Issue 2010-11**

The Great Lakes Association of College and University Housing Officers (GLACUHO) is seeking an experienced professional in the area of Student Conduct to serve on our executive board as the chair of Contemporary Issues from November 2010-November 2011.

The Contemporary Issues Committee was created in order to address a relevant topic within Housing and Residence Life for the duration of a one year period. The topic is selected by the President. Any content expert in the area of Student Conduct who are employed in our region (Michigan, Ohio, Indiana or Illinois) are encouraged to apply.

The topic for the 2010-11 year is Student Conduct. Some of the areas we want this committee to consider are:

- 1) What are current best practices in the area of student conduct as it relates to philosophy, approach, sanctions and follow-up?
- 2) What is the current terminology in the field of student conduct?
- 3) What recent legal cases have implications for the conduct process?
- 4) What kind of training programs should Housing and Residence Life departments develop in order to develop new and entry level professionals into competent conduct officers?
- 5) How to integrate student conduct and residence life.
- 6) How do you work collaboratively with offices that coordinate the conduct process (i.e. Dean of Students, Student Conduct office, etc.)?
- 7) What are challenges to not coordinating the conduct process internally?
- 8) What types of judicial software is available for housing officers?
- 9) Trends (i.e. restorative justice, conflict mediation, etc.)
